Contact brianna.savage@princestrust.ca Through BCIT's new Associate Certification in Construction of Mass Timber Structures program launching in January 2023, **Carpenters and ironworkers will have the chance to participate in a six-month upskilling program to contribute to a more sustainable future.**

Prince's Trust Canada is forming a cohort of four to eight interested students from equity deserving groups, which we will support through value-added programming and financial support. Participants must be 18-30, have at least one year of work experience in carpentry or ironwork and have completed a minimum Foundation program in either discipline. We are especially interested in supporting women, female-identifying participants and people of colour.

Working online and in-person, Prince's Trust Canada cohort program is designed to provide students with **additional** technical knowledge in mass timber construction and construction management of projects, emphasizing the installation and practical skills in the on-site installation of the structures. Additional cohort sessions will also focus on problem-solving, creativity, teamwork, project management and one-on-one networking sessions with the industry experts.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

BCIT's associate certificate program is a part-time program that introduces students to the mass timber industry and explores fundamental features and tools associated with mass timber construction.

BCIT'S Program Format:

This part-time program runs for 6-months (January 2023 – June 2023), with two weeks of in-person practicum to gain hands-on experience constructing a mass timber building at BCIT.

Courses will cover planning, installation and on-site construction and developing hard and soft skills.

BCIT's Certificate Program Will:

- Provide an overview of the main characteristics and properties of mass timber products
- Outline basic structural components, connections, building systems, and site installation for mass timber construction
- Introduce the main types of building enclosures based on climate considerations and code requirements
- Provide fundamental knowledge about building system performance in terms of fire performance and sound insulation
- Provide basic principles of construction management, including construction planning.
- Provide visualization of a mass timber construction project
- Introduce the basic principles of cost estimation for mass timber construction
- Introduce digital manufacturing with wood and digital project delivery

Who is Eligible?

Prince's Trust Canada is interested in supporting all individuals who meet the program requirements laid out by BCIT. We are especially interested in helping Indigenous, Black and people of colour, queer and female-identifying individuals.

A participant must be able to commit to an extra 3 hours per month (1.5-hour sessions, twice a month) for cohort meetings and sign a commitment contract reflecting the participant's willingness and commitment to the cohort.

How to Apply?

BCIT has directed the program requirements, and we will support you in getting your paperwork together for your final application. BCIT will have the final authority of program entry.

CHECKLIST:

- High school transcripts showing **completion** of Math 10 (or equivalent) and English Studies 12 (or equivalent) (scanned)
- Completion of a Carpentry Framing and Forming Foundation or Ironworker Foundation Program (or construction management building inspection, design, development, manufacturing or estimating.)
- Copy of certification of Fall Safety Protection Training (within last three years)
- Letter from employer proving a minimum of 1-year experience on a construction site
